CURRICULUM

High school students can choose from an extensive catalog of more than 200 courses. Eligible students grade 9-12 may enroll in our Dual Enrollment program powered by Acadeum with Baker College, Western Texas College, Southeastern University and Franklin University. Course selections include multiple options of pre-approved core subjects that satisfy school credit requirements for graduation at K12 Private Academy. Additionally, many K12 Private Academy comprehensive, honors and AP® level courses may be used for NCAA athletic eligibility.

GRADING SCALE

Class rank will be calculated using courses taken at K12 Private Academy as well as courses transferred in. The student must be enrolled for at least two consecutive terms on a full-time basis. The following comment will be placed on each student's transcript, "The weighted GPA for transfer courses will be based on K12 Private Academy's guidelines for assigning quality points". Our school offers multiple start dates for both the fall and spring terms. For this reason, the student's final spring term will have an end date between May and August.
